### THE ASSOCIATION OF SUBURBAN MUNICIPALITIES ELECTS ITS EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE FOR 2018 – 2019

**MONTREAL WEST; DECEMBER 6, 2017:** At their first post-municipal elections meeting on November 30, the suburban city mayors that comprise the Association of Suburban Municipalities elected the four Executive Committee members who over the next two years will oversee ASM operations and planning initiatives. The members elected and the positions they will hold are:

*“I am truly honored to have been elected president by my fellow mayors”* quoted Mr. Masella. *“I’m really looking forward to working with my new EC members. They bring a combination of experience, energy and commitment that will definitely be needed to succeed with the political challenges that we can expect over the next 2 years of our mandate”*.

As indicated by Mayor Masella at the November 30 Agglomeration Council meeting, the immediate priority for the new ASM Executive Committee is to convene a meeting as soon as possible between the ASM cities mayors and Mayor Valérie Plante and her team and initiate a dialogue on issues of common interest (and concern).

The Association of Suburban Municipalities represents 15 municipalities on the Island of Montreal, with an approximate total population of 245 000 citizens. The municipalities include Dollard-Des-Ormeaux, Côte-Saint-Luc, Pointe-Claire, Kirkland, Westmount, Beaconsfield, Town of Mount Royal, Dorval, Hampstead, Montreal West, Montréal-Est, Baie-D'Urfe, Senneville, Sainte-Anne-de-Bellevue and Dorval Island.
