## **ASSOCIATION OF SUBURBAN MUNICIPALITIES EXECUTIVE BOARD'S ELECTION: BENY MASELLA RE-ELECTED PRESIDENT**

**Montreal West, December 17, 2021** - The Association of Suburban Municipalities (ASM) announces the re-election of Mr. Beny Masella, mayor of Montreal West, as president. He will be supported on the executive by two vice-presidents, Alex Bottausci, mayor of Dollard-des-Ormeaux and Julie Brisebois, mayor of Senneville. Finally, Christina M. Smith, Mayor of Westmount, will assume the treasurer's function. The mandate duration of the new Executive Council is four years (2021-2025).

"I would like to thank my colleagues, the mayors, for renewing their confidence to assume this new mandate. It is an honour and a pleasure to work alongside people who care about reliable municipal management and the quality of life of their fellow citizens. I also want to underline the participation of all ASM members. They make possible a change of issues that concern us all, in particular questions relating to taxation and governance of the agglomeration, by representing us in the various bodies in which we are present," said Beny Masella, president of the AMB and Mayor of Montreal West.

In addition, the mayors of demerged cities agreed last Tuesday on the sharing of responsibilities that will have to be assumed by the agglomeration within the committees and commissions, that is to say, the Metropolitan Community of Montreal (CCM) as well as the Union of Quebec Municipalities (UQM). In addition to the nominations to the UMQ, the Agglomeration Council will approve these nominations on December 23.

### **About the Association of Suburban Municipalities**

The Association of Suburban Municipalities is an association of fifteen linked cities of the Montreal agglomeration, each autonomous in its municipal management and voice. Together they count 250,000 citizens.
